Subject: E-Waste collection targets for the financial year 2021-2022 under the EPR provision of the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 in wake of COVID-19 pandemic - reg.

The Ministry has received requests from the electrical and electronic industry associations regarding waiving off the collection targets for the financial year 2021-2022 under the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) provision of the E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

- 2. As per the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016, all producers of electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) have to achieve the e-waste collection targets assigned to them by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) while being given EPR authorization. The collection targets for the current financial year 2021-2022 is 50% of the quantity of waste generation as indicated in Extended Producer Responsibility Plan.
- 3. The matter has been examined in the Ministry in consultation with Central Pollution Control Board. Keeping in view the continuous effect of COVID-19 pandemic for almost 2 years and its impact on the electrical and electronic industry and its capacity to fulfill EPR obligations, Ministry has decided to reduce the targets for e-waste collection from 50% to 40% for the current financial year 2021-22. Further, shortfall (up to 10%) over the revised target i.e. 40% be allowed to be carried forward in the financial year 2022-23.
- 4. This issues with the approval of the competent Authority.
