Subject: Assistance to State Govt. of Madhya Pradesh for the Annual Plan Operation (General Works) during 2022-23 for implementing during 2023-24 under the CSS: Forest Fire Prevention & Management – Release of 4th installment.

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 24.11.2022, I am further directed to convey the approval of the competent authority for sanction of **Rs. 319.78 Lakh** (Rupees Three hundred nineteen Lakh and seventy eight thousand only) **(25% of Central Share) and net release of Rs. 319.78 Lakh** (Rupees Three hundred nineteen Lakh and seventy eight thousand only) as release of 4th installment of Annual Plan Operation 2022-23 for implementing during 2023-24, **under CSS: Forest Fire Prevention & Management Scheme** to the **State of Madhya Pradesh for the financial year 2023-24** subject to the condition that the State Government on 60%: 40% cost sharing basis as Central Share and State Share.

2. The expenditure incurred is adjustable to the Demand No. 28. (Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change) under the following Heads during Financial Year 2023-24 (Plan):

3. The various works are to be executed as per the Sanctioned Schedule of Rates applicable in the area. The aforesaid amount may be spent in accordance with the Plan Operation sanctioned as given in **Annexure** and **no deviation from the approved items of expenditure** shall be made **without prior concurrence** of Government of India.

4. **This release amount is subject to adherence of the terms and conditions mentioned in this Ministry's letter of even number dated 24.11.2022.**

5. Further, State should ensure that all the payments should be made only through Aadhar based Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) for target based delivery of benefits and submit a certificate that all payments were done by using Aadhar Payment Bridge (APB) along with the Utilization Certificate and Progress Report.

6. The accounts of the Forest Fire Prevention & Management Scheme shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit party by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry whenever it is called upon.

7. In accordance with the revised procedure the Reserve Bank of India may please be advised to pass on the credit to the Central Accounts Section, Nagpur for transferring the funds to the accounts of Government of **Madhya Pradesh** and to debit the amount to the Account of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

8. This issues with the concurrence of Internal Finance Division vide their **Dy. No. E-135773 dated 11.10.2023 under** the powers delegated to the Ministries/Departments.
