Greetings from India!

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Govt. of India is in receipt of the letter dated 14.06.2024 from the Director of the General Directorate of Environmental Quality and National Focal Point to the Minamata Convention, Peru forwarding Form A for seeking consent for export of 60,000 kg (~1739 flasks) mercury from Peru to India.

2. No PIC has been issued against the said Form A.
3. Further, MoEF&CC has received two applications from M/s KBNM Metals Pvt. Ltd. for seeking PIC for import of total 17,250 kg (500 flasks) from Peru.
4. The application of the importer (M/s KBNM Metals Pvt. Ltd.) has been examined. Accordingly, the consent for import of mercury for the total quantity of 15,525 kg (450 flasks) is hereby furnished in the aforementioned Form-A (as enclosed) for use in manufacture of mercury salts which is allowable purpose under Minamata Convention.
5. With this, the total quantity remaining is 44,475 kg (~1289 flasks) against the quantity of 60,000 kg (~1739 flasks) provided in the Form A dated 14.06.2024 provided by National Focal Point, Peru.
